Using the library

Registering

To use the library services, you need a library card. You can register online or at the library. On your first visit to the library, please bring ID with you so that your library card can be activated. A card is required for everything to do with borrowing books at the terminals (self-checkout, renewals, reservations, cash and card payments) or using the Digital Library of Eastern Switzerland (Dibiost). Children and young people under the age of 17 require written permission from a parent.

Fees

Children and young people can use all library services free of charge. Over the age of 18, a fee has to be paid to borrow media items.

The annual fee for adults covers the loan of all media items, and includes use of the Digital Library of Eastern Switzerland (Dibiost).

Lending conditions

Books, comics, audio books,

music CDs, maps, tonies 28 days
Films, magazines,

media for parties 14 days

A maximum of 30 media items can be borrowed per library ticket

Renewals

The loan period for all media items can be extended twice, unless they have been reserved by another user. Please renew online at "Mein Konto".

Returns

All media items can be returned to the boxes by the returns desk in the library or at any time outside the main entrance to the library or at Jona Town Hall.

Reserving media

Media that are out on loan can be reserved free of charge online at "Mein Konto" or through the library. Up to 10 items can be reserved per library card and these will be held ready for you to collect for 7 days.

Reminders

Please give us your email address so that we can send you a reminder three days before the end of your loan period. If the loan period is exceeded, you will receive a warning and a fee will become payable. After the second unsuccessful reminder you will be invoiced for the cost of replacing the item in question.

Ways to pay

You can pay all fees using the payment module at the self-checkout terminal either in cash, by Postfinance or credit card. When your annual subscription is about to expire, you will be sent an invoice for renewing it.

Please handle all media items carefully. If they are damaged or lost, you will be charged accordingly. The Rapperswil-Jona town library accepts no liability for damage caused to equipment by the use of borrowed sound, image or data carriers.
